Last year Stewart Steel put up the last 40 feet of our grandstand for a cost of \$55,388.55, and this spring the seats were installed. We have approximately 12,000.00 in our grand stand account to date and with the fundraisers that we have planned for this year we hope to raise that total. The quote to put a roof on it is approximately \$60,000.00 so we still have a lot of fund raising to go, but we hope to be able to put the roof on before our 100th Anniversary in 2008.
